This funding will be used to

- Strengthen teacher pedagogy with targeted coaching and collaborative professional release focussed on data analysis, action planning and tracking progress in Reading (100% of staff engaged in the coaching program)
- Support learners identified at below National Minimum Standards in Reading (100% above NMS year 3 and 5) through the development of a Whole School Approach to the Teaching of Reading with support from co-teachers from the Active Learning Team
- Increase teacher knowledge and refine processes in identifying and supporting high performing students in the area of Reading (Increase the percentage of students in U2B Reading Year 3 - 69% to 75% and 5 – 48% to 55%) and ensure improvement in relative gain year 3 to 5 with targeted support in years 2 and 4
- Refine Coaching program to support improved pedagogy around the Teaching of Reading and alignment of practice across the school
- Optimise learning time by minimising classroom disruption through upskilling teachers in classroom profiling and Essential Skills in Classroom Management

Our initiatives include

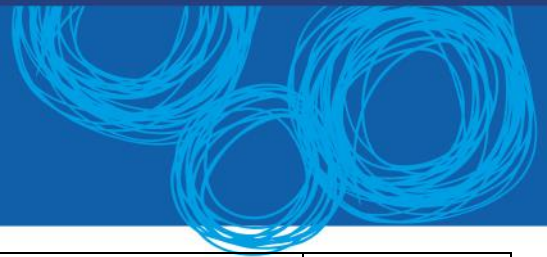
- Weekly Collaborative Professional Release (CPR) enabling year level groups and facilitator to focus on targeted data, analyse student outcomes, action plan for improved outcomes and track progress
- Development of a co-teaching model of service within the Active Learning Team to support teacher identification of students with support or extension needs, and provisioning for these students
- Develop a plan for monitoring early phase literacy, including the schedule of Early Start Assessments and ICAS assessments (English/Maths), opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention
- Review Whole School Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Frameworks to ensure alignment with practice, targeted data collection tools and analysis processes
- Ensure all staff are provided with induction to key pedagogical approaches within the school

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Maximise learning opportunities by minimising class interruptions through improved teacher classroom management – Essential Skills Training and Classroom Profiling	\$3000
Create purpose built data collection tools to match initiatives with Bardon SS and generate effective data tools	\$4000
Employ additional support personal to target early intervention and extension and enrichment programming	\$10000
Purchase additional resources to support the development of the Guided Reading model at Bardon SS (including ICAS assessment English/Maths Year 2 and 4)	\$14002
